UAF Summer Sessions Field Photography Course John River, Gates of the Arctic National Park and Preserve July 25 to August 6, 2017

Join photographer Richard Murphy on a float down a National Wild River in Gates of the Arctic National Park. This field photography workshop focuses on outdoor wilderness photography in a sub-arctic wilderness environment: from vast landscapes, to flower details, to the John River itself. Much of the content of the workshop will be participant-driven and there will be time to investigate individual artistic interests. This workshop can accommodate a wide range of photographic skill and photographic equipment. While learning about photography, we will also canoe, hike and camp in one of the wildest, most remote areas of Alaska. Don and Tracie Pendergrast, National Park Service Volunteers, will teach paddling and back country skills and lead Wilderness discussions throughout the trip.

\$3800.00 includes airfare from Fairbanks into the Park and back, all food and group equipment. Individuals will need to supply their own personal equipment.
